



Home Learning in Reception

What will we be doing?

- **Reading Books** – every child will have a reading book sent home in their book bag every day. These will be changed when your child has finished the book and an **adult has signed the Home School Book**. Reading books will be changed on a **Monday and Thursday**.
- Ideas for practical activities and learning opportunities will be given weekly on the Newsletter.
- **RWinc** – we will send home the speedy sound packs which will contain the sounds the children have been learning. Each week on the Newsletter we will let you know which sounds your child has been learning so that you can practise these at home.
- **RWinc Virtual Classroom** – each weekday you will be sent a link to the Ruth Miskin Virtual Classroom. This link allows you to access a short teaching video for your child to watch and join in with.

What would we like you to do?

- Try and spend 10 minutes each day listening to your child read and record it in their Home School Book.
- Talk about the book that they are reading – do they like it? Who is their favourite character and why? What do they think will happen in the end?
- Practise saying the sounds that have been sent home. Please see the following website for more information for parents, including a pronunciation guide to saying the sounds correctly:
